Off Licence

Section 17 to 20, 64 and 135, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012



Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **Casita Miro Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at **3 Brown Road Waiheke Island Auckland**, and known as **Casita Miro**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold on or delivered from the premises on Good Friday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) Only grape wine made on the premises or from produce harvested from land on which the premises are situated may be sold on Easter Sunday.
- (c) Alcohol may be sold only while the premises are operating as a winery cellar door and continue to qualify under section 32(1)(g) of the Act, and only during the following days and hours:

Monday to Sunday 11.00am to 9.00pm

- (d) Only the following types of alcohol can be sold under this licence:
 - (i) Grape wine made by or behalf of the licensee, on the premises or from produce harvested from land occupied by the licensee.
 - (ii) Alcohol manufactured by or for the licensee (or a partner or affiliate).
 - (iii) Under the Casita Miro brand or other brands owned by the licensee (or a partner or affiliate).
 - (iv) Imported Spanish wine and sherry.
- (e) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers immediately adjacent to any alcohol that is being supplied free as a sample on the premises.
- (f) No intoxicated persons may be allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.
- (g) Appropriate signage regarding the restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons must be prominently displayed adjacent to every point of sale.
- (h) The whole of the premises is undesignated.
- (i) The licensed premises are more precisely identified as outlined in the plan date stamped as received by Auckland Council on **7 October 2024**

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licenses, this licence continues in force—

- (a) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed.

This licence expires at the close of 1 June 2025 unless renewed.
